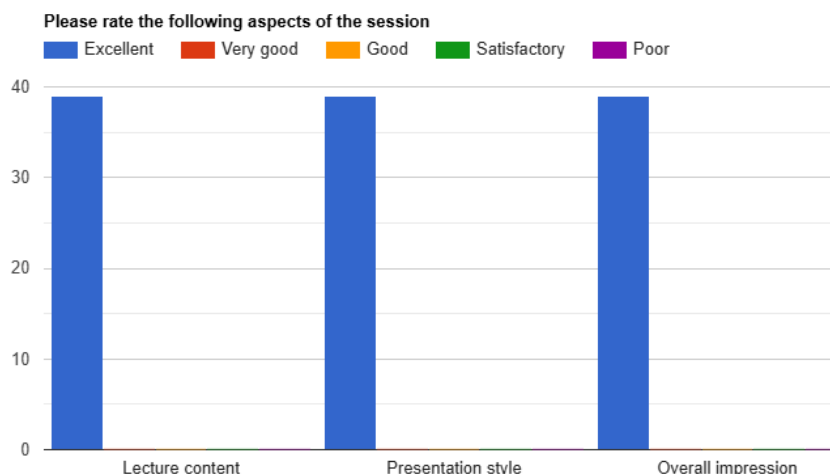

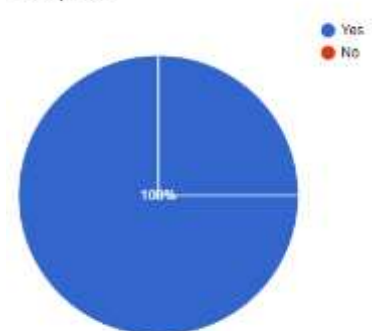

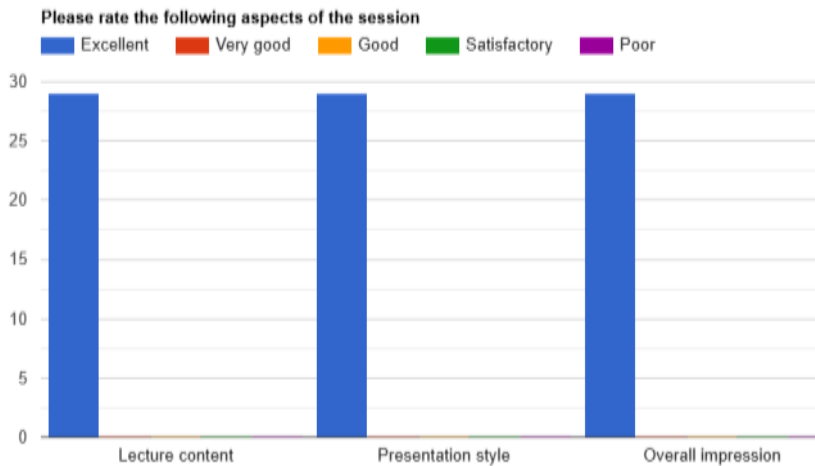

- Total feedback received from 74 participants, from three different broadcasts



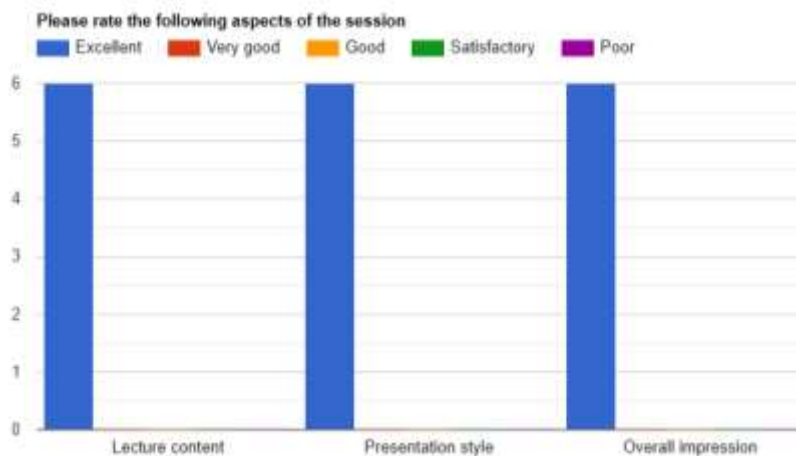
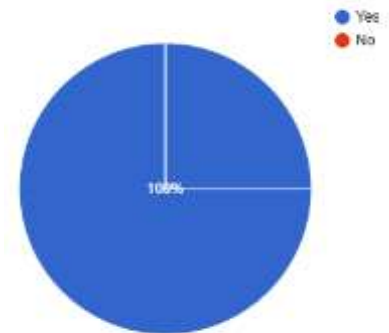
